








I-THE MULTI-ACTOR PLATFORM

- Based on the members of the Leader Programming Committee for 2014-2020
- Complemented by referents on the thematic
- 3 groups:
- -Researchers : 2 geographers, 1 scientist, 1 sociologist et 1 agronomist
- -<u>Decision-makers</u>: 2 mayors, 1 regional councilor, 1 French state representative, 1 representative of the Generalitat de Catalunya
- -Socio professionals: 1 farmer, 1 fisherman, 1 food company manager, 2 stakeholders of citizen groups, 1 representative of a slow food association



2-THE THEMATIC: THE "TFP" OR TERRITORIAL FOOD PROJECT

This project, called TFP **Mar i Munt** in Catalan, will make possible to relocate food and reconstitute a food ecosystem that enhance the value of the territory's resources, in order to "produce well" and "eat well". Food that must be accessible to everyone.

In order to respond to these issues, several projects are underway:

- The preservation and reclamation of agricultural land and sustainable management of water resources,
- The process of agroecological transition,
- Improving the network and structuring the entire food value chain, from production to processing,
- The deployment of more organic, local and accessible collective catering,
- Developing inclusion though food,
- Promoting the link between health, justice and food education.



3-THE EXCHANGES AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE "SHERPA POSITION PAPER"

- Several in-person meetings
- Exchanges through on-line platforms
- A collective construction
- Consensus for the recommendations



4-A LEADER 2023-2027 PROGRAM BASED ON THE SHERPA POSITION PAPER

- A new Leader program for the territory in parallel, based on the work of the SHERPA platform
- Thematic: ecological transition
- A part signposted on the TFP, which will allow to finance the food transition actions



5-PROPOSALS FOR EUROPEAN POLICIES

The first recommendation of the SHPERPA PPM platform is therefore to have the TFP recognized an promoted at European level as a tool for supporting agricultural and food transitions in rural areas.

The second recommendation is to promote TFPs by securing a 5% envelope in the rural development programs to support their implementation in rural territories and the projects they support. At a regional level, it's also a question of making possible the access to LEADER funding for TFP projects or to provide ad-hoc funding.

The third recommendation is to "reward" virtuous territories that set up a TFP, for example by developing a label or a TFP bonus financed under the second pillar of the CAP.
